We hope this letter finds you well as you transition beyond your collegiate athletic career. We want to inform you of your eligibility for the NCAA-sponsored Post-Eligibility Insurance Program, which provides coverage for athletic-related injuries sustained on or after August 1, 2024.

As a recently separated student-athlete from an NCAA Division I, II, or III member institution, you are eligible to file an insurance claim for any qualifying injuries. This coverage remains available for up to two years (24 months) following your separation from your institution, ensuring continued medical support for athletic-related injuries.

Key details of the Post-Eligibility Insurance Program include:

- **Eligibility:** Any former NCAA Division I, II, or III student-athlete who sustained an athletic-related injury on or after August 1, 2024.
- Coverage Period: Extends up to 24 months post-separation from your institution.
- Claim Coordination: If your playing institution has an existing claim on file, the insurance company and claims payor will coordinate benefits accordingly to ensure appropriate coverage.
